Thence, entering Skagit County, Washington, at a point in Section 36, T-33-N, R-4-E, continuing across said county in a northwesterly direction a distance of approximately 25 miles to a point of exit from said county in Section 1, T-36-N, R-3-E.

Thence, entering Whatcom County, Washington, at a point in Section 36, T-37-N, R-3-E, continuing across said county in a northwesterly direction a distance of approximately 9 miles to a point in said county in Section 21, T-38-N, R-3-E, said point being at Bellingham, Washington, and being the termination of the main pipe line.

II. The following gathering pipe lines and supply lateral pipe lines:

PICEANCE CREEK SUPPLY LATERAL PIPE LINE

Piceance Creek Supply Lateral Pipe Line approximately 50 miles in length, in Rio Blanco County, Colorado, and more particularly described as follows:

Colorado

Beginning at a point in Section 5, T-2-S, R-96-W, Rio Blanco County, Colorado, said point being located approximately 35 miles southeast of Rangely, Colorado.

Thence, running in a westerly direction approximately 50 miles to a point of termination at the main pipeline in said county in Section 19, T-1-N, R-101-W.

PICEANCE CREEK FIELD GATHERING PIPE LINE

A gathering pipe line in the Piceance Creek Field, approximately eight miles in length, in Rio Blanco County, Colorado, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in Section 29, T-2-S, R-95-W, Rio Blanco County, Colorado.

Thence, running in a northwesterly direction approximately 8 miles to a point of termination at the Piceance Creek Supply Lateral Pipe Line in Section 5, T-2-S, R-96-W.
