ACCESS ROAD EASEMENT

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of SIXTY DOLLARS (\$60.00) in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we, ROBERT V. LEWIS and GRACE E. LEWIS, husband and wife at the time of acquiring title and ever since, have granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and its assigns, a permanent easement and right-of-way approximately 14 feet in width, with such additional widths as are necessary to provide for cuts, fills, and turnouts and for curves at the angle points, all over and across the lands of the undersigned in

The N½ of the NE¼ and the SE¼ of the NE¼ of Section 18, Township 2 North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington,

for the following purposes, namely: the right to enter and to clear of timber, endangering trees, and brush; to grade, level, cut, fill, drain, build, maintain, repair, and rebuild a road or highway and such culverts, bridges, turnouts, retaining walls, or other appurtenant structures as may be necessary, on, over, and across the land embraced within the right-of-way, the center line of which is described as follows:
