Agreement dated July 6, 1955, with State Highway Commission, State of Wyoming, granting permission to cross U. S. Hwy. #30-S at a point in S. 21, T. 18 N., R. 111 W., Sweetwater County, Wyoming.

Agreement dated August 16, 1955, with Union Pacific Railroad Company granting permission to cross said company's right-of-way and tracks in S. 2, T. 18 N., R. 112 W., Sweetwater County, Wyoming.

Letter dated June 6, 1955, from the State of Wyoming. Office of Commissioners of Public Lands and Farm Loans, Cheyenne, Wyoming, granting permission to cross all state owned lands along the route of the pipeline in Sweetwater County, Wyoming.

(Compressor Station Site No. 6) Interim letter dated August 15, 1955, from the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management, Cheyenne, Wyoming, affording permission to proceed with construction on the following described premises, to-wit:
