WARRANTY DEED

Know All Men by These Presents, That we, ~~Gordon M. Bergstrom and Lucille Bergstrom~~, husband and wife, in consideration of Ten and no/100 Dollars to us paid by Lena Bergstrom, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Lena Bergstrom her heirs and assigns, all the following real property, with the tenements, heriditaments and appurtenances, situated in the \_\_\_\_\_ County of Skamania and State of Washington, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the southwest corner of the east half of the north east quarter of the north east quarter of section 34, in Twp 2 North of Range 6 E.W.M., running thence North to State Road as of November 5th, 1907, (the same now being a County road) thence along said State Road, now County Road in an easterly direction to a creek about 4 chains; thence following said creek down stream in a southeasterly direction to the south line of said North east quarter of North east quarter of said section 34; thence west on said line to place of beginning, containing one and one fourth acres, more or less.

Beginning at the corner common to sections 26, 27, 34 and 35 in Twp. 2 N.R.6.E.
