DECLARATION OF TRUST

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that whereas the citizens residing in the vicinity of the Hemlock Ranger's Station have organized and are now conducting a church organized for the worship of God which said organization is non-demoninational; and Whereas the said citizens have constructed a building upon property owned by the declarants which said church building has been so constructed by donated labor and material; And Whereas there now exists no incorporation or other legal entity capable of holding title to the premises upon which said building is located; And Whereas the declarants hereinafter named being the owners of the fee simple title to the property herein described desire to donate the use of said real property for the purpose aforesaid;

Now therefore these presents Witnesseth that the declarants William Denne and Irene M. Denne, husband and wife, do hereby declare that they have donated for the use of the community the premises upon which the church above mentioned stands to-wit, the following described real property in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

Commencing at the intersection of the northerly line of the Hemlock Road with the southerly line of the Little Soda Springs Road in Section 26, Twp. 4 N. R. 7 E. W. M. the said point being approximately 400 feet South and 30 feet West of the Northeast corner of the East half of the West half of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section 26, thence west along the northerly line of said Hemlock road a distance of 100 feet, thence Northerly at right angle to the northerly line of said road a distance of 175 feet more or less to the southerly line of said Little Soda Springs road thence Southeasterly along the southerly line of the Little Soda Springs Road to the point of beginning.
