

at the International Boundary between the United States and Canada near Sumas, Washington, and more particularly described as follows:

TWENTY-SIX-INCH MAIN PIPE LINE

COLORADO

BEGINNING at a point in Section 36, T-34-N, R-9-W, La Plata County, Colorado, said point being located approximately nine miles NW of Ignacio, Colorado;

THENCE, running in a northwesterly direction approximately 28 miles to a point of exit from said county in Section 29, T-36-N, R-12-W.

THENCE, entering Montezuma County, Colorado, at a point in Section 29, T-36-N, R-12-W, continuing across said county in a northwesterly direction a distance of approximately 39 miles to a point of exit from said county in Section 19, T-39-N, R-17-W.

THENCE, entering Dolores County, Colorado, at a point in Section 18, T-39-N, R-17-W, continuing across said county in a northwesterly direction a distance of approximately 22 miles to a point of exit from said county in Section 30, T-42-N, R-19-W.

THENCE, entering San Miguel County, Colorado, at a point in Section 19, T-42-N, R-19-W, continuing across said county in a northwesterly direction a distance of approximately three miles to a point of exit from San Miguel County, Colorado, in Section 14, T-42-N, R-20-W.

UTAH

THENCE, entering San Juan County, Utah, at a point in Section 14, T-33-S, R-26-E, continuing across said county in a northwesterly direction a distance of approximately 50 miles to a point of exit from said county in Section 2, T-27-S, R-22-E.

THENCE, entering Grand County, Utah, at a point in Section 35, T-26-S, R-22-E, continuing across said county in a northeasterly direction a distance of approximately 69 miles to a point of exit from Grand County, Utah, in Section 32, T-18-S, R-26-E.
