In any Certificate of Gas Supply filed prior to April 1, 1959, the signer of such Certificate shall treat gas to be received by the Company from Westcoast as part of the gas supply of the Company even though facilities for effecting deliveries of such gas to the Company shall not yet have been completed by Westcoast.''

(c) The definition of "complete, completed, completion, Completion Date" is amended to read as follows:

"The terms 'complete', 'completed' and 'completion', when used with reference to the initial stage of pipe line development, shall mean completion and actual commencement of operation of the Pipe Line System at a stage at which

- (i) it has an operating capacity of not less than 343,000 MCF of natural gas per day at 14.73 pounds per square inch absolute, deliverable at points on the Pipe Line System and in quantities complying with the requirements of the gas sales and transportation contracts of the Company then in effect, and
- (ii) it will have a maximum operating capacity, after subsequent completion of the second stage of pipe line development, of not less than 644,500 MCF of natural gas per day at 14.73 pounds per square inch absolute (including capacity for the handling of 303,000 MCF per day of Canadian gas when such gas shall be available for delivery to the Company at the northern terminus of the Pipe Line System), deliverable at points on the Pipe Line System and in quantities complying with the requirements of the gas sales and transportation contracts of the Company then in effect,

in each case including as a part of such System upon completion of the initial stage of pipe line development (a) twelve compressor stations having an aggregate rated horsepower of not less than 76,300, (b) three field booster stations having an aggregate rated horsepower of not less than 5,830, and (c) all other items of property acquisition or capital expenditure which under customary pipe line construction procedures constitute part of the Pipe Line System as so completed, all in accordance with the Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity granted by Order of the Federal Power Commission in Docket No. G-1429 issued June 18, 1954, as modified, supplemented and expanded by Order of the Federal Power Commission in Docket Nos. G-8932 et al. issued November
