25, 1955, and as said Certificates may at the time have been modified, supplemented or amended by other Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing only permitted changes, as issued to the Company by the Federal Power Commission.

"The terms 'complete', "completed' and 'completion', when used with reference to the second stage of pipe line development, shall mean completion and actual commencement of operation of the Pipe Line System in accordance with said Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity granted by said Orders of the Federal Power Commission issued June 18, 1954 and November 25, 1955 (as said Certificates may at the time have been modified, supplemented or amended by other Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing only permitted changes, as issued to the Company by the Federal Power Commission), with a maximum operating capacity of not less than 644,500 MCF of natural gas per day at 14.73 pounds per square inch absolute, including capacity for the handling of 303,000 MCF of Canadian gas when such gas shall be delivered to the Company at the northern terminus of the Pipe Line System, and including all items of property acquisition or capital expenditure which under customary pipe line construction procedures constitute part of the Pipe Line System as so completed.

"The term 'Completion Date' shall mean the date when the initial stage of pipe line development is completed."

(d) A new definition is inserted after the definition of the term "Completion Date" reading as follows:

"Compressor stations on public lands:

"The term 'compressor stations on public lands' shall mean and include all compressor stations and structures and facilities forming part of or appurtenant to compressor stations (not including pipe lines, equipment or structures of the nature referred to in Subparagraph (d) of the definition of 'property additions' in Article 1 hereof) located, constructed or installed by the Company on, over or under government lands or other public lands underleases or permits from federal, state, municipal or other public authorities, and shall also mean and include all said leases and permits, provided in each case, that such leases shall expire (or be renewable at the option of the Company for terms expiring) not less than five years after the maturity of the latest maturing Bonds outstanding at the time the respective lease was obtained and not earlier than October 1, 1982, and provided further that, in the
