

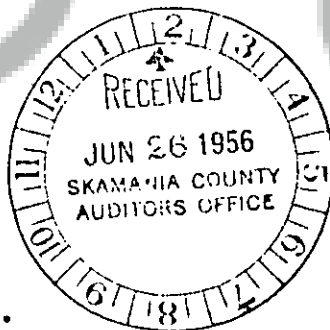
PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

ROY H. DOBBS and VETA M. DOBBS, husband and wife, the owners and holders of of that certain mortgage dated December 8, 1950, executed by L. B. Johnston and Violet M. Johnston, husband and wife, to secure payment of the sum of Two Thousand Seven Hundred and No/100 (\$2,700.00) Dollars and interest according to the terms and conditions of one promissory note of even date therewith, and recorded in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County, State of Washington, on December 14, 1950, at page 446 of Book Y of Mortgages, being auditor's file no. 41884, do hereby release and discharge from the lien of said mortgage the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington:

A tract of land situated in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and in Government Lot 2 of Section 16, Township 1 North, Range 5 E.W.M., described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the southerly right of way line of State Highway No. 8 with the east line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the said Section 16; thence following the southerly line of said highway right of way south 85° 20' west 385 feet; thence south to the meander line of the Columbia River; thence northeasterly following the meander line of the Columbia River to intersection with the southwest corner of Government Lot 3 of the said Section 16; thence north along the west line of Government Lot 3 to the point of beginning.

This release, however, shall not impair the validity of the said mortgage as to the other real property therein described.

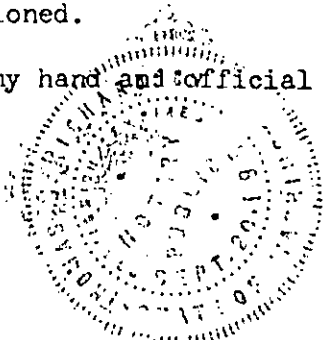
