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casing, tubing, derricks, machinery, appliances, equipment, fittings, fixtures and property connected or to be connected therewith.

*Other Property*

Together with all the right, title and interest of the Company now owned or hereafter acquired in and to all lands, real estate, chattels real, surface leases, surface rights, rights-of-ways, easements, servitudes, transportation systems, distributing systems, gathering systems, pipe lines, pipe line equipment, pipes, stations, sub-stations, meters, meter houses, regulators and regulator houses, tanks, gates, compressors, compressor stations, telephone and telegraph lines, electric power lines, poles, wires, auxiliary equipment, casings, oil or gas wells, oil or gas well equipment, valves, oil or gas lease equipment, bridge licenses and bridge rights, franchises, permits, privileges, grants, leases, consents, licenses and patent rights, and also all plants, buildings and structures, with their fixtures and appurtenances, all machinery, mechanical equipment, electrical equipment, and machine shops, now owned or hereafter constructed or acquired, of whatever character and wherever situated, all of which are to be considered as part and parcel of the real estate covered hereby and all of which, together with such real estate, are to be considered and dealt with as a whole.
