Edgar Lackey and Fay Lackey, husband and wife, the following described real estate, situate in the county of Skamania state of Washington:

Parcel #1. Commencing at the meander post to sections 28 and 29, Tp. 3 N. R. 10 E.W.M., thence along section line between sections 28 and 29, N. O deg. 05' E. 249.42 feet to a point in the south line of the S. P. & S. right of way for the northwest corner of the Johnson tract; thence along the south line of the said right of way N. 74 deg. 12' E. 1550.40 feet to the northeast corner; thence along the east boundary line of the Johnson tract, the same being the west line of the Drano Flume & Lumber Co. tract S. 18 deg. 17' E. 512.85 feet to the southeast corner on the U.
