WARRANTY DEED

THE GRANTORS, Randall L. Mickley an unmarried man, residing at Washougal, Wash. for and in consideration of Ten Dollars in hand paid, conveys and warrants to J. McEnery and Doris L. McEnery, husband and wife the grantees the following described real estate, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Twenty-three (23), Township Two (2) North, Range Five (5) East of the W.M.; thence westerly along the North line of the South Half of said Southeast Quarter of said Section Twenty-three (23) to the East line of the right of way of the Washougal Guard Station Road; thence southerly along the East line of the right of way of said road to a point marked by an iron pipe driven into the ground where the south spring on said south half of the Southeast Quarter of said Section Twenty-three (23) crosses the Washougal Guard Station Road in a Cedar Culvert; thence Easterly on a line parallel to the South line of said Section Twenty-three (23) to the east line of said Section Twenty-three (23); thence North along the East line of said Section Twenty-three (23) to the point of beginning; all of the same lying and being in the said South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section Twenty-three (23) Township 2 North of Range Five (5) East of the W.M. containing 27 acres more or less.
