BORROW PERMIT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Robert C. Prindle and Louise A. Prindle, husband and wife, of Washougal, Washington for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Four Hundred \$2400.00 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and warrant unto the STATE OF WASHINGTON, the exclusive right, permit, license and lease to use and occupy the hereinafter described lands at any and all times from date hereof until June 1, 1954—19\_\_, for the purpose of excavating and removing highway materials in any quantity, consisting of rock, gravel, sand and/or earth from any portion of said lands, storing and stockpiling crushed rock or other highway materials thereon, and operating all necessary machinery and equipment thereon, said lands being situated in Skamania County, State of Washington, and described as follows, to-wit:
