STATE OF WASHINGTON IN CONSIDERATION OF One thousand three hundred eighty-seven and and 50/100 (\$1,387.50) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the State of Washington does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Roy H. Dobbs and L. B. Johnston, their heirs and assigns, the following described School lands, situated in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

Lot 3, section 16, township 1 north, range 5 east, W.M. containing 27.75 acres, more or less, according to the government survey thereof. Subject to easement for right of way for state road heretofore granted under State Road Plat No. 247. Subject to easement for right of way for logging road heretofore granted under application No. 882. Subject to easement for right of way for railroad heretofore granted under application No. 3237.
