Description of Tract

A parcel of land lying in Government Lots 1 and 2, Section 23, Township 3 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian in Skamania County, Washington, said parcel of land being a portion of the following described property:

Commencing at a United States Engineer's monument set at the northeast corner of Block 2, First Addition to the Town of Underwood, Washington; thence N. 83°43'35" E. 190.00 feet along the southerly line of Main Street extended; thence north 60.00 feet to a point which is the initial point of the description of said parcel; thence north 105 feet, more or less, to the southeasterly right-of-way line of the Underwood Hill Highway as the same existed on July 8, 1942;
