Whenever used in this Amendment No. 1 to Exhibit "C", the abbreviations "NE/4", "NW/4", "SW/4", "SE/4", "N/2", "W/2", "S/2" and "E/2", shall mean respectively, the "North East 1/4", "North West 1/4", "South West 1/4", "South East 1/4", "North 1/2", "West 1/2", "South 1/2" and "East 1/2", all with reference to the subdivision of lands according to the United States Government Survey thereof. The abbreviations "T", "R", "Sec." and "N.M.P.M." shall mean respectively, "Township", "Range", "Section" and "New Mexico Principal Meridian". The abbreviations "N" and "W" when used with reference to a township and range, respectively, shall mean a township north of the base line and a range west of the New Mexico Principal Meridian according to the United States Government Survey.

The references under the column heading "Company File No." identify the leases for Company filing purposes and are included herein for informational purposes only.

All leases described in Part 1 of Schedule I of Amendment No. 1 to Exhibit "C" were granted by the United States of America as lessor, and all references in said Part under the column heading "Federal Serial No." refer to the records of the District Office of the Bureau of Land Management, United States Department of the Interior, at Santa Fe, New Mexico.

All leases described in Part 2 of Schedule I of Amendment No. 1 to Exhibit "C" were granted by the State of New Mexico as lessor. All references under the column heading "State Serial No." are to the files of the Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico located at Santa Fe, New Mexico.

The reference in Schedule II of this Amendment No. 1 to Exhibit "C" under the column heading "Jicarilla Apache Tribal Number" refer to the files of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, United States Department of the Interior, located in Washington, D. C. The lease described in said Schedule was granted on behalf of said Tribe of Indians as lessor by its Chairman.
