

## SCHEDULE 1—Part 2

## GARFIELD COUNTY

(Western Slope Sales Meter Station Site): Decision dated March 14, 1957, from the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management, Land Office, Denver, Colorado, approving right of way for sales meter station in Garfield County, Colorado, being a tract of land out of the property of the United States of America, in a portion of S. 20, T. 7 S., R. 102 W., 6th Principal Meridian, Garfield County, Colorado, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the corner common to Sections 20, 21, 28 and 29, T-7-S, R-102-W, 6th Principal Meridian, Garfield County, Colorado, from which the northeast corner (iron pipe) of said tract bears west along the south line of said Section 20, 470 feet; thence, N 46° 12' E, 3 feet; then, N 32° 15' E, 40 feet; thence, N 18° 16' E, 120.7 feet; thence, N 71° 44' W, 12.3 feet; thence, N 71° 44' W, 53.84 feet to an iron pipe for corner, in the easterly right of way line of a county gravel road; thence, S 34° 31' W, 104.18 feet along the said easterly right of way line to an iron pipe for corner; thence, S 71° 44' E, 83 feet to an iron pipe for corner; thence, N 18° 16' E, 100 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.16 acres of land.
