STATE OF IDAHO

BANNOCK COUNTY

(Pocatello Tower Site): Decision dated January 15, 1957, from United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management, Land Office, Boise, Idaho, granting advance permission to construct a radio tower site in Bannock County, Idaho, being a tract of land 50 foot square in the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 35 East, B.M., Idaho.

(Pocatello Sales Meter Station Site): Lease dated March 23, 1956, from the City of Pocatello, Idaho, for a term of 20 years with option of renewal by lessee for an additional 20 years on the following described property in Bannock County, Idaho:

Beginning at the center of Section 2, Township 7 South, Range 34 East, B.M.; thence, in a westerly direction along the center of said Section 2, 500 feet to a point in the easterly right of way line of a gravel road; thence, S 12° 55' W, 329 feet along the said right of way line to the true point of beginning said point being the NW corner of the herein-described tract; thence, S 12° 55' W, 175 feet along the said right of way to a point; thence, S 77° 05' E, 50 feet to a point; thence, N 12° 55' E, 175 feet to a point; thence, N 77° 05' W, 50 feet to the true point of beginning. The herein-described tract of land to contain 0.20 acres of land, more or less.

KOOTENAI COUNTY

Agreement dated June 19, 1956, from the Spokane International Railroad Company, granting permission to cross said Railroad's right of way and tracks at a point in Section 3, T-50-N, R-4 W, W.B.M., Kootenai County, Idaho. (Line 516 33 R W 6-28-123).

NEZ PERCE COUNTY

Agreement dated July 13, 1956, from the State of Idaho, Department of Highways, granting permission to cross Old U. S. Highway #95 at a point in Section 28, Township 36 North, Range 5 West.
