Henry Greer to Ida B. Greer.

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 18th day of December 1950 by and between Henry Greer and Ida B. Greer, husband and wife, residing in the town of Carson, Wash. in Skamania County: WITNESSETH:

That whereas said Henry Greer and Ida B. Greer are the owners of certain real property described as follows: to-wit:

Lots numbered three (3) and Four (4) in block number C in the original town of Carson as shown by a plat of said town on file in the Office of the Auditor of Skamania County Washington. All of the above described property being held in the name of Henry Greer and it being desired that said property as well as any other property owned or belonging to either spouse shall pass without delay or expense in the case of the death of either of said parties, to the survivor:

NOW THEREFOR in consideration of the love and affection that each of said parties has for the other, it is hereby agreed that in case of the death of said Henry Greer, while said Ida B. Greer survives the whole of the said property hereinbefore described, as well as any other property now owned or hereafter aquired, shall at once vest in said Ida B. Greer in fee simple; and in event of the death of Ida B. Greer, while the said Henry Greer survives, the whole of said property, together with any other property subsequently aquired shall at once vest in said Henry Greer in fee simple.

Portland Oregon Local Council of Girl Scouts, Inc. to United States of America.

EASEMENT DEED - CORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: that Portland Oregon Local Council of Girl Scouts, Incorporated, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oregon, hereinafter called the "Grantor," does hereby grant and convey to the United States of America, acting by and through the Forest Service, U. S. D. A., and assigns, hereinafter called the "Government," a non-exclusive easement and right-of-way, including but not limited to, the right, privilege and authority to locate, construct, re-locate, maintain, patrol and repair a roadway and electric and telephone transmission lines over, upon, along and across the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

A strip of land 66 feet in width traversing the following described real property:

E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, T. 3 N., R. 9 E., W.M.

The said strip being 33 feet in width on each side of a center line of a road as located and to be constructed on the ground with as much additional width as required for adequate protection of cuts and fills, said center line being more particularly described as follows:
