SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON

YAKIMA COUNTY & PUG. CO. 192512

Beginning at a point approximately 40 feet west of the section corner common to Sections 25 and 36, T. 3 N., R. 8 E., and Sections 30 and 31, T. 3 N., R. 9 E., thence in a northeasterly direction over and across the E $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 25, T. 3 N., R. 8 E., and over and across the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; and NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30 for approximately 5,500 feet to a point on the east boundary of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 30, T. 3 N., R 9 E., approximately 1,300 feet southerly from the  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner common to Sections 19 and 30, T. 3 N., R. 9 E.

Together with reasonable rights of ingress, egress and regress to and from said lands for the purposes designated.

The rights, privileges and authorities herein granted are for full use and enjoyment by the Government for any and all purposes deemed necessary or desirable in connection with the control, management and administration of the national forest or the resources thereof. The rights, privileges and authorities herein granted shall continue as long as used for the purposes granted but if for a period of Five years the Government shall cease to use the rights, privileges and authorities for the purposes granted or shall abandon the use of the easement herein granted then, in any such events, the Grantor may terminate this easement and all rights hereunder shall revert to the holder of the fee title to the lands.

The Grantor, its contractors and assigns, shall have the right to use said road for the hauling of logs from lands now owned by it which are naturally tributary to said road and for its other purposes, subject to reasonable regulation by the Forest Service.
