CONFIRMATORY FLOWAGE EASEMENT

THIS INDENTURE made this 31st day of March, 1951, by and between Oregon Lumber Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Utah, hereinafter called the Grantor, and the United States of America, hereinafter called the Government, WITNESSETH:

THAT WHEREAS, the Government has constructed a dam across the Columbia River between the States of Oregon and Washington at Bonneville, Oregon and upon the completion of said
