WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Estella Pearl Voight and Charles H. Voight, husband and wife (whose names are correctly spelled as Estella Pearl Voigt and Charles H. Voigt) in consideration of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) and no consideration Dollars, to us paid by Jessie V. Allhands and Genelle V. Jackson, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Jessie V. Allhands and Genelle V. Jackson, not as tenants in common but with the right of survivorship, their assigns and the heirs of such survivor, all the following real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances situated in the County of Skamania, and State of Washington, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the $NW_{\frac{1}{4}}$ of the $SW_{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Sec. 36 T. 3 N. R. 7 E. of Will. Provided, however, that the grantees herein do not take the title in common but with the right of survivorship; that is, that the fee shall vest absolutely in the survivor of the grantees.

Voight, husband and wife, the grantors above named, do covenant to and with the above named grantees, their heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises; that the above granted premises are free from all encumbrances, and that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators, shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, Witness our hands and seals this 2nd day of August, 1950.
