ATKINS, husband and wife, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said CHARLES B. ARKINS and LAURA M. ATKINS, their heirs and assigns, all the following real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances, situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the west boundary line of Section 34, Township 2 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, where said boundary line intersects with the center of the channel of Washougal River; thence in an easterly direction following the center of the channel of said Washougal River to a point 400 feet east of thewest boundary line of said Section 34, Township 2 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, which said last-mentioned point is the place of beginning of the tract herein conveyed, and also which last-mentioned point is the southeast corner of a tract of land heretofore convehed by Eav King to Fred Haskell and Olga S.
