th), Bords, in addition to those the issuance of which is other also provided for in this Article 1, may be executed by the Company and delivered to the Trustee, and shall be authenticated by the Trustee and delivered to or upon the written order of the Company, in an aggregate principal amount not in excess of \$15,900,000, to the extent of 75% of \$21,200,000 of the net bondable value of (A) second stage property additions and (B) property additions consisting of production expenditures which shall be purchased, constructed, developed, acquired or extended prior to a date five years after the Completion Date, but only upon receipt by the Trustee of the following document-specified in this 1,00, which, if delivered to the Trustee with respect to production expenditures, instead of referring to second stage property additions, shall refer to property additions consisting of production expenditures:

(b) Subdivision (veii) of -i.o.(u) is renumbered (xviii), and a new subdivision (xvii) is inserted after subdivision (vvi) reading as follows:
