

PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned RAY S. SAMPSON and SYBIL R. SAMPSON, husband and wife, the owners and holders of that certain mortgage to the undersigned bearing date of November 19, 1957, and recorded in Book 34 of Mortgages, at page 33, under auditor's File No. 53056, for value received, do hereby release and discharge from the lien of the aforesaid mortgage, the following described portion of said mortgaged property, situated in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

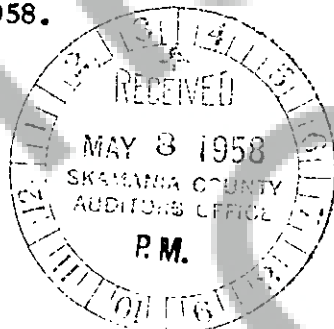
A portion of the North Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 19, Township 1 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Section line 56 rods South of the Northwest corner thereof; thence East to the Quarter Section line; thence South to the South line of the North Half of the Northwest Quarter; thence West to the Section line; thence North to the point of beginning;

A 25 foot square tract surrounding a spring located approximately 980 feet East and 180 feet South of the Northwest corner of said Section 19 with easement to install and maintain a pipeline from spring to above described property; Skamania County, Washington.

The execution of this instrument shall not be deemed to release nor otherwise affect the lien or security of the aforesaid mortgage as to the remainder of the mortgaged premises not released hereby.
