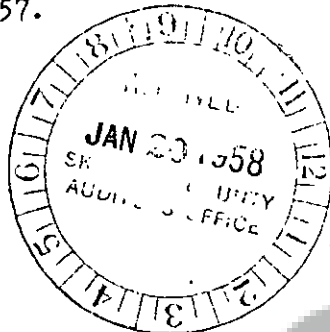
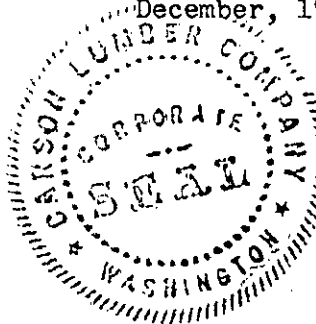


## RELEASE OF MORTGAGE
