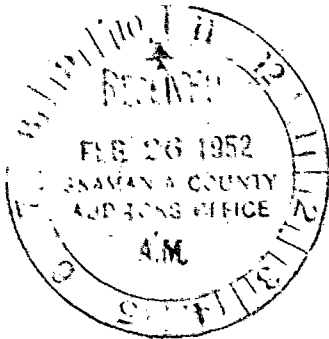

QUITCLAIM DEED

The North Half ( $N\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the  
 Southeast Quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Six (6), Township three  
 (3) North Range Eight (8) East of Willamette Meridian.
