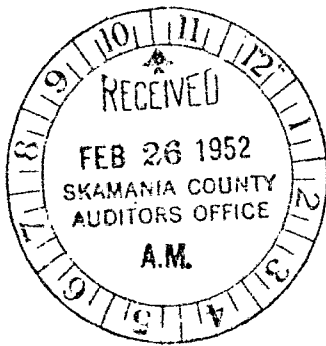

QUITCLAIM DEED

The Director, State Department of Agriculture, State of Washington, hereinafter called the Director, acting pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 169, Laws of Washington, 1951 for and in consideration of \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter called the Government and to its assigns all of his right, title and interest in and to the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

The North Half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Six (6), Township three (3) North Range Eight (8) East of Willamette Meridian.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Director has caused this quitclaim deed to be executed and delivered to the Government on this 28 day of JANUARY, 1952, pursuant to an agreement, entered into under Section 2 (f) of the Rural Rehabilitation Corporation Trust Liquidation Act (64 Stat. 99, 40 U.S.C. 440 (f)), which agreement provides for the conveyance by the Director of said real property back to the Government for sale and use by it of the sales proceeds in carrying out the purposes of Titles I and II of the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act and in accordance with the applicable provisions of Title IV thereof as now or hereafter amended.
