THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That

Long-Bell Lumber Company

engaged in the business of logging and lumbering in the State of Washington, has complied with the provisions of the act of the Legislature approved March 16, 1897, being section 34 of chapter 89 of the Session Laws of 1897, and acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto.

By virtue of compliance with the provisions of said acts and the payment to the State of Washington of the sum of Eight Thousand One Hundred Forty-nine and no/100 (\$8,149.00) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby certified to, the said

Long-Bell Lumber Company

is hereby granted the right to occupy for purposes of right of way for hauling or removing timber or ties, the lands situate in the County of Skamania, and said State of Washington, more particularly described as follows:

Those portions of government lots 3 and 4, Section 34, Township 7 North, Range 6 East, W.M., and those portions of the bed and shorelands of Lewis River owned by the State of Washington in front of government lots 3, 4, 5 and 6, said Section 34, included within the limits of a strip of land of variable width on each side of the following described center line:

Beginning at a point in said lot 4 on the center line of an existing right of way covered by Application No. 20572, which is S 0° 05' E 1262.40 feet and S 80° E 894.5 feet from the northwest corner of said Section 34, and running thence S 34° 04' E with a width of 50 feet on the left and 50 feet on the right 108.1 feet, thence on a 14° curve to the left 137.1 feet, thence S 53° 16' E 240.6 feet, thence on a 20° curve to the right, 102.3 feet, thence S 32° 48' E 165.8 feet, thence on a 40° curve to the right 143.3 feet, thence S 24° 30' W 163.4 feet, thence on a 16° curve to the left, 185.9 feet, thence S 5° 15' E 84.5 feet, and thence S 5° 15' E with a width of 300 feet on the left and 300 feet on the right 1,000.00 feet to a point in said lot 6 which is N 38° 55' 17" E 2268.38 feet from the southwest corner of said Section 34, and having an area of 8.99 acres according to the plat thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.

Subject to an easement for a right of way for a logging road covered by Certificate No. 1301 issued to Harbor Plywood Corporation on January 20, 1949 for a term of 10 years under Application No. 20572.



Subject to all the terms, conditions and reservations of Chapter 109 of the Session Laws of 1911, to which reference is hereby made, as fully as though set out at length herein.

This right of way certificate is issued for a period of Five (5) years
from April 10, A. D. 195 2.

for the purpose for which it was granted, it shall be deemed forfeit.
