Beginning at a point on the northerly line of the county road known and designated as Gropper Road, said point being 320 feet easterly of the center line running north and south through the center of the NWE of the said Section 36; thence north 208 feet; thence east 208 feet; thence south 208 feet, more or less, to the northerly line of the said Gropper Road; thence north 186 feet to the initial point of the tract hereby described; thence north 99.5 feet, more or less, to the center line of the natural gas pipeline constructed by Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation; thence following the center of said pipeline north 58° east 108 feet, more or less, to the westerly line of the county road known and designated as Maple Way; thence south following the westerly line of said Maple Way to a point north 74° east of the initial point; thence south 74° west 102 feet, more or less, to the initial point; SUBJECT TO Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation pipeline easement.

together with the appurtenances, and all awnings, screens, mantels, and all plumbing, lighting, heating, cooling, ventilating, elevating and watering apparatus and fixtures now or hereafter belonging to or used in connection with the property, all of which shall be construed as a paper of the realty.

To secure the performance of the covenants and agreements here nafter contained, and the payment of FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE and No/1004 - 11111- (\$555.00) - - - - - - dollars with interest from date until paid, according to the terms of 1958. Certain promissory note bearing even date herewith.

The mortgagor covenants and agrees with the mortgage as follows: that he is lawfully seized of the property in fee simple and has good right to mortgage and contest it; that the property is free from all liens and incumbrances of every kind; that he will keep the property free from any incumbrances prior to this mortgage; that he will pay all taxes and assessments levied or imposed of the property and/or on this mortgage or the debt thereby secured, at least ten days before delinquency, and will immediately deliver proper receipts therefor to the mortgagee; that he will not permit waste of the property; that he will keep all buildings now or hereafter placed on the property in good order and repair and unceasingly insured against loss or damage by fire to the extent of the full insurable value thereof in a company acceptable to mortgagee and for the mortgagee's benefit, and will deliver to mortgagee the policies, and renewals thereof at least five days before expiration of the old policies.

Should the mortgagor default in any of the foregoing covenants or agreements, then the mortgagee may perform the same and may pay any part or all of principal and interest of any prior incumbrance or of insurance premiums or other charges secured hereby, and any amount so paid, with interest thereon at the highest legal rate from date of payment shall be repayable by the mortgagor on demand, and shall also be secured by this mortgage without waiver of any right or other remedy arising from breach of any of the covenants hereof. The mortgagee shall be the sole judge of the validity of any tax, assessment or lien asserted against the property and payment thereof by the mortgagee shall establish the right to recover the amount so paid with interest.

Time is of the essence hereof, and if default be made in the payment of any of the sums hereby secured, by in the performance of any of the covenants or agreements herein contained, then in any such case the remainder of unpaid principal, with accrued interest and all other indebtedness hereby secured, shall at the election of the mortgagee become immediately due without notice, and this mortgage may be foreclosed.

In any suit which the mortgagee may be obliged to defend to protect the unimpaired priority of the lien hereof, the mortgager agrees to pay a reasonable sum as attorney's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, and also the reasonable cost of searching records, which sums shall be secured hereby and included in any decree of foreclosure:
