The Grantor, Pacific Power & Light Company, a corporation of the State of Maine, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), to it in hand paid by the Grantees herein, hereby releases, conveys and quitclaims to Mary Jessup, widow of J. M. Jessup, deceased, her heirs and assigns, and to The United States of America, to the extent of its interest and ownership in said Lot Four (4), all of said Grantor's right, title and interest in and to Lots Four (4) and Five (5), Section Twenty-six (26), in Township Three (3) North, Range Nine (9), East of Willamette meridian, in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, not used or required in said Grantor's operations, excepting, however, from this conveyance and expressly reserving to the Grantor those two (2) certain rights of way for electric power transmission lines across that portion of said Lots Four (4) and Five (5) of said Section Twenty-six (26), lying east of the public highway as established July 5, 1921. The portions of said real property hereby reserved and excepted from this conveyance are more particularly described in that certain deed executed by said J. M. Jessup and Mary Jessup, his wife, as Grantors, to Northwestern Electric Company, as Grantee, its successors and assigns, dated August 31, 1925, and recorded in Book 11, at Page 416, of the Deed Records of said Skamania County.

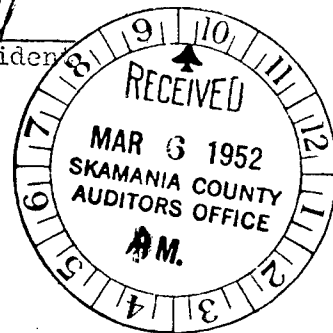
