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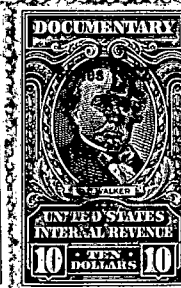
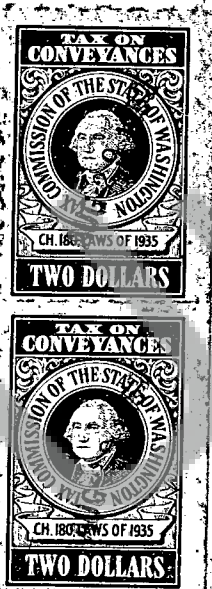

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That GEORGE W. CHERRY and LOUISE CHERRY, husband and wife, in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10) Dollars and other valuable consideration paid to them by SHEPARD & MORSE LUMBER COMPANY, a Maine corporation, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said Shepard & Morse Lumber Company, its successors and assigns forever all of the timber with a diameter breast-high of 24 inches or more and of every kind, nature and description which now is or which may be from now until December 31, 1953, lying, standing or growing upon the following described land in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

The southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 33, Township 2 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian,

together with the right to enter upon and to do any and all acts thereupon necessary or convenient for the purpose of removing said timber, and together with the right to use any material located on said lands for the purpose of improving or constructing roads for grantee's use in logging and removing said timber, subject, however, to the following conditions and restrictions:

1. No timber with a diameter breast-high of less than 24 inches shall be cut, felled or logged from the premises.
2. No timber shall be cut within a radius of 40 feet from the existing cabin on the premises.
3. No road shall be constructed closer than 100 feet to said cabin.
