(c) Certain other pipe lines, and certain compressor stations, gas treating and/or dehydration plants and facilities, gasoline extraction plants and other related facilities;

all as described generally in Part II of Article Four of the Seventh Supplemental Indenture (as modified by the Eleventh and Fourteenth Supplemental Indentures) and in Part I of Article Four of the Eighth Supplemental Indenture (as modified by the Eleventh and Thirteenth Supplemental Indentures); and subject in all cases to changes in size of pipe and other details not materially affecting the capacity and efficiency of the Loop Line Project upon its completion. The term "Loop Line Project" shall not, however, include any part of the "Phoenix Branches" as defined below.

The term "Phoenix Branches" as used herein, shall mean the four branch pipe lines described as follows:

- (i) a pipe line, approximately 30.6 miles in length and consisting of approximately 9.3 miles of 16-inch pipe line and 21.3 miles of 10¾-inch pipe line, commencing at a point of connection with the Company's 26-inch main transmission pipe line near Mile Post 590 in Maricopa County, Arizona and extending in a northerly direction to a point near the Company's Lateral 16 City Gate Station near the city of Phoenix in said Maricopa County;
- (ii) a 4½-inch pipe line, approximately 10.2 miles in length, commencing at a point of connection with the Company's Guadalupe Regulator Station in Maricopa County, Arizona and extending in an easterly direction to the Company's Mesa City Gate Station near the city of Mesa, Maricopa County, Arizona;
- (iii) a 4½-inch pipe line, approximately 1.72 miles in length, commencing at a point of connection with the Company's Guadalupe Regulator Station in Maricopa County, Arizona and extending in a northerly direction to a point of connection in said Maricopa County with the Company's 4½-inch and 3½-inch branch pipe line to Tempe, Arizona; and
- (iv) a 12¾-inch pipe line, approximately 5.42 miles in length, commencing at the Company's Phoenix City Gate Station No. 1 in Maricopa County, Arizona and extending in a
