COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 19th day of 1953, by and between Howard E. Ericson and Leona Ericson of Skamania County, Washington, WITNESSETH:

That whereas said Howard E. Ericson and Leona/Ericson, as husband and wife, are the owners of certain community property, and whereas all of the property now owned, or which shall come into the possession hereafter of said parties is hereby declared to be their community property, and whereas said parties are now desirous of providing for the disposition of said property on the death of either, under and by virtue of and in conformity with the provisions of Section 6894 Remington's Compiled Statutes of the State of Washington, and to provide that said property and all property by them hereafter acquired, both real and personal, wheresoever situated, shall pass without delay or expense to the survivor, in case of death of either of said parties:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the love and affection that each of said parties has for the other, IT IS HEREBY AGREED that in case of the death of the said Leona Ericson while the said Howard E. Ericson survives, the whole of said property hereinbefore described, together with any property by them hereafter acquired, shall at once vest in the said Howard E. Ericson, in fee simple, as his sole and separate property, and in the case of the death of the said Howard E. Ericson leaving the said Leona Ericson surviving, the whole of said property hereinbefore described, together with any property by them hereafter acquired, shall at once west in the said Leona Ericson, in fee simple, as her sole and separate property.
