(2) That title to the above described real property be and it is hereby quieted in J. A. Robbins and William J. Wineberg, plaintiffs named above, free and clear of all claims on behalf of Skamania County; and

(3) That the sum of \$35.18 heretofore paid into the registry of this court by the plaintiffs be and it is hereby ordered to be paid to the Treasurer of Skamania County in payment of the belance due upon the contract referred to above and in payment of taxes upon the property described in such contract as set forth above; and

erainst the defendants for their costs and dishursements to be taxed berein.
