in hand paid, convey and warrant to Kenneth F. Doolittle and Remona R.

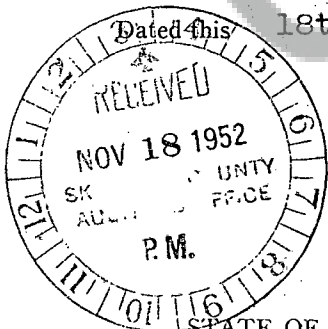
Doolittle, husband and wife, Carson, Washington

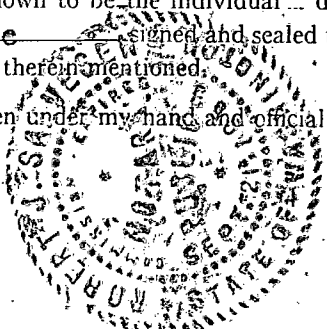
