

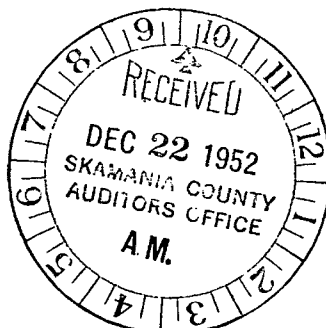
ASSIGNMENT

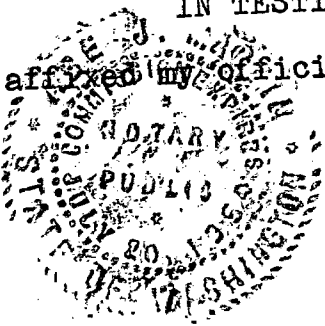
