Canada which may be transported into the United States by the Company or for delivery to it for use in the United States during the term of any export permit or license is restricted, there shall be excluded in determining the daily volume of gas available to the Company from such source any part of such daily volume in excess of an amount determined by dividing the aggregate volume deliverable from such source pursuant to such permit or license by the number of days included in the term of such permit or license, but no further consideration need be given to the fact that the term of such permit or license is restricted; and if the Company's right to transport or receive, or the right of any supplier to deliver to the Company, gas produced in Canada from any source is limited to the right to transport or receive or deliver gas for resale in specified areas in the United States, there shall be excluded in determining the daily volume of gas available to the Company from such source any part of such daily volume in excess of the average daily requirements of the Company under its then existing gas sales contracts covering gas to be sold in such specified areas; and, if such daily volume is at the time curtailed by a temporary restriction which by its terms is limited to a specified period, appropriate adjustments may be made to reflect the temporary character of such curtailment.

The signer or signers of any Certificate of Available Gas Supply in determining the amount of available gas supply of the Company through deliveries from any pipe line supplier may, if he or they shall consider such information reliable and of sufficiently recent date and so state in such Certificate, rely on any figures relating to the gas supply of such pipe line supplier contained in the certificate of gas supply signed by a person who would qualify as an independent geologist under this Indenture (except that such person need not be selected or paid by the Company) most recently filed with the trustee under an indenture securing bonds or other obligations of said pipe line supplier if, pursuant to the terms of said indenture, the signer of such certificate of gas supply, in rendering the opinion set forth therein, shall be required to consider substantially the same factors in determining the pipe line supplier's available gas supply as are required to be considered by the signer of a Certificate of Avail-
