in the County of Skamania, State of Washington,

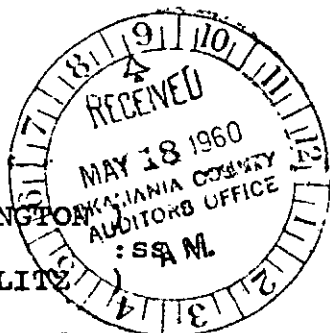
Lots seven (7) and Eight (8) of

any covenant or agreement aforesaid, then the whole indebtedness
hereby secured shall forthwith become due and payable, at the election
