

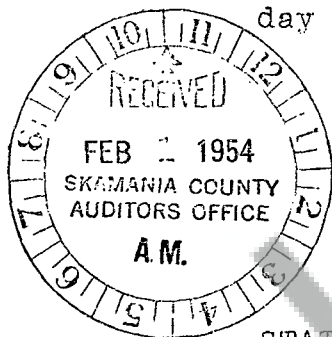
QUITCLAIM DEED AND ASSIGNMENT
