

Permit Amendment dated September 17, 1958, from A. J. Roybal, Acting Forest Supervisor, amending Carson National Forest Special Use Permit dated September 26, 1957, to include additional lands across the Carson National Forest. (Line 711, R/W 2-21-183.)

Agreement dated September 4, 1956, with the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Arriba County, granting permission to cross State Highway No. 17, at a point in Section 26, T-29-N, R-6-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. (Line 706, R/W 2-21-133.)

Map approved September 15, 1958, by Sidney Carney, Acting Superintendent, Jicarilla Apache Indian Agency, Dulce, New Mexico, granting permission to cross certain lands along the route of the pipeline under the jurisdiction of the Jicarilla Apache Indian Agency in Dulce, New Mexico. (East Tapacito and West Campanero Gathering Systems.)

Map approved October 31, 1958, by John B. Keliiaa, Superintendent, Jicarilla Apache Indian Agency, granting permission to cross certain lands along the route of the pipeline under the jurisdiction of the Jicarilla Apache Indian Agency in Dulce, New Mexico.
