KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That HERMAN DENNIS METZ and CLARA CHRISTINE METZ, husband and wife, herein called the Grantors, in consideration of Ten and no/100ths DOLLARS to them paid by ARTHUR C. TICE and ROSE A. TICE, husband and wife, herein called the Grantees, do hereby give and grant unto the said Grantees, their heirs, successors and assigns, a perpetual easement for the purpose of ingress and egress to and from the following described property situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

> The S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 3 North, Range $7\frac{1}{2}$ East of the Willamette Meridian and any adjoining property now owned, or hereafter acquired, by the Grantees.

Said easement shall consist of a stip of land 20 feet wide, the center line of which is described as follows, to-wit:

time desire to change the location of the easement herein conveyed, such changes may be made upon the agreement of the parties hereto, their respective heirs or assigns, provided the Grantors shall, at their own cost and expense, locate and establish a road of similar width and at least as good as the road herein established and as may then be improved.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said easement unto the said Grantees, their heirs and assigns forever.
