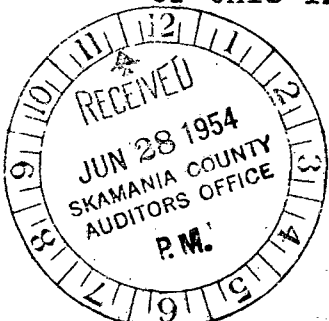
QUIT CLAIM DEED
