SUBJECT to the right hereby reserved by the Grantor, its successors and assigns, to vary and control at all times the flow of the White Salmon River by the operation of the Condit Hydroelectric Plant situated upstream from the property described herein, and

RESERVING unto the Grantor, its successors and assigns, the right to enter upon said premises at any time for patrol purposes in connection with the operations of said power plant or for other purposes in connection with its business as a public utility.

GRANTEE COVENANTS that all of its operation on Grantor's property pursuant to this easement will at all times be conducted in such manner as not to interfere with the operation and maintenance of said Oondit Hydroelectric Plant and activities incidental to such operation and maintenance.

All rights hereunder shall cease when said fish holding facilities and appurtenances shall have been abandoned.
