J-8 Lands in Umatilla County, State of Oregon:

J-8 Item 3: That portion of that part of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 9, Township 5 North, Range 28 East, Willamette Meridian, lying north of the County Road, which lies west of the westerly right of way boundary of the Bonneville Power Administration's McNary-Pasco transmission line right of way survey, said westerly right of way boundary being a line 75 feet westerly of and parallel to the following described center line:
