

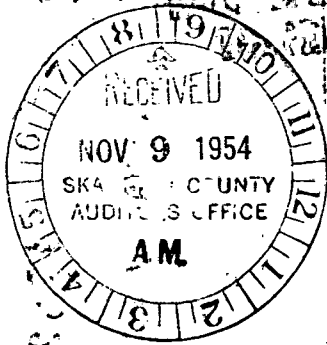

WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of
Six thousand nine hundred sixty-three and 22/100 - - (\$6,963.22) - - dollars,
in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey
unto said party of the second part the following-described real estate and premises situated in
Skamania County, State of Washington
on the Public Domain Indian Reservation, to wit:
Lots 1, 2 and 3 and SW/4 NE/4, Sec. 4, T. 3 N., R. 10 E., W. M., Washington, con-
taining 156.89 acres.

Title to the land herein described shall be subject to any existing easements for
public roads and highways, for public utilities, and for railroads and pipe lines
and any other rights-of-way of record, as well as reservation for ditches or canals
constructed by authority of the United States.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging. And the said
parties of the first part, for themselves and their heirs, executors, and administrators,
do hereby covenant, promise, and agree to and with the said party of the second part,
its successors and assigns, that they will forever warrant and defend the said premises against the
claim of all persons, claiming or to claim by, through, or under them only.
