

## E A S E M E N T

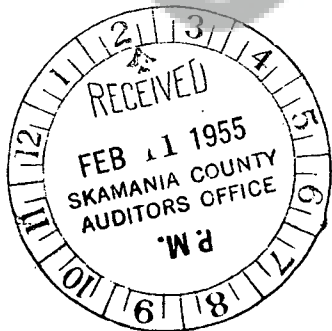
EUGENE HARDING, a married man dealing with his separate property, and acting by and through Willard J. Hutson, his Attorney in Fact, for and in consideration of Twenty Five and No/100 (\$25.00) Dollars, in hand paid, grants, bargains, sells and conveys to MILES I. STEVENSON and CLARENCE V. AUGEE, their heirs and assigns, an easement for the use in common with others of the existing logging road as now constructed and established on, over and across the following described real property in Skamania County, Washington:

The west half of the southwest quarter ( $W\frac{1}{2}$   $SW\frac{1}{4}$ )  
of Section 20, Township 3 North, Range 8 E.W.M.;

for a period of five years from and after the date hereof, at the end of which time all rights granted hereunder shall automatically cease and terminate.

The aforesaid easement shall be used by the grantees, their employees, heirs, and assigns, for the purpose of removing logs and timber products from real property in Township 3 North, Range 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  E.W.M. now owned by the grantees or in which they may hereafter acquire any interest. The grantees covenant and agree to keep and maintain the said logging road in its present state of repair.
