IN THE MATTER OF Primary State Highway No. 8, Wind River to Wind MountainKNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that LAVERA N. SHEPARDSON, also known of recordas LAVERA N. STANDISH and LESLIE O. SHEPARDSON, wife and husband.

for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and No/100 - Dollar s,  
 in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do        hereby grant and  
 warrant unto the STATE OF WASHINGTON the right, privilege and permit to waste, place  
 and deposit earth materials of all types and quantities upon the hereinafter describ-  
 ed lands, at any and all times from date hereof until June 1 1957,  
 said lands being situated in SKAMANIA County, State of Washington, and  
 described as follows:

All that portion of Government Lot 2, Section 35, Township  
 3 North, Range 8 East W. M., lying Southwesterly of a line parallel with  
 and 175 feet distant Northeasterly, when measured at right angles and/or  
 radially, from the center line of Primary State Highway No. 8, Wind River  
 to Wind Mountain, said line extending from Highway Engineer's Station  
 395+00 Southeasterly to the Easterly boundary of said Government Lot 2.  
 EXCEPTING, any and all portions of said Government Lot 2, lying South-  
 westerly of the Southwesterly right of way line of existing Primary  
 State Highway No. 8.

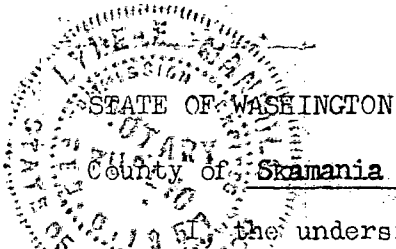


The specific details concerning all of which are to be found within that cer-
