

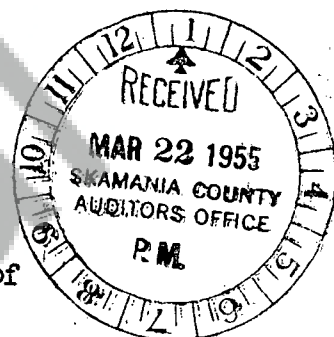
PERMIT TO WASTE EARTH MATERIALS

IN THE MATTER OF Primary State Highway No. 8, Wind River to Wind Mountain -

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that HAUSER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, an Oregon Corporation,

for and in consideration of Twenty five and NO/100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and warrant unto the STATE OF WASHINGTON the right, privilege and permit to waste, place and deposit earth materials of all types and quantities upon the hereinafter described lands, at any and all times from date hereof until June 1, 1957, said lands being situated in SKAMANIA COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, and described as follows:

All that portion of Government Lot 3, Section 35, Township 3 North, Range 8 East, W. M., lying Southwesterly of a line parallel with and 175 feet distant Northeasterly, when measured at right angles and/or radially, from the center line of Primary State Highway No. 8, Wind River to Wind Mountain, said line extending from the Westerly boundary of said Lot 3 Southeasterly to Highway Engineer's Station 398+00. EXCEPTING and portion of said Government Lot 3 lying Southwestesterly of the Northeasterly right of way line of Primary State Highway No. 8.



The specific details concerning all of which are to be found within that certain map of definite location now of record and on file in the office of the Director of Highways at Olympia, Washington, and bearing date of approval June 29, 1954, revised February 8, 1955.

The right, privilege and permit of ingress and egress over and across other lands owned by the Grantor herein, and not hereinabove described, for a haul road of sufficient width to conveniently transport said earth materials, is also hereby granted to the State of Washington by the Grantor herein.

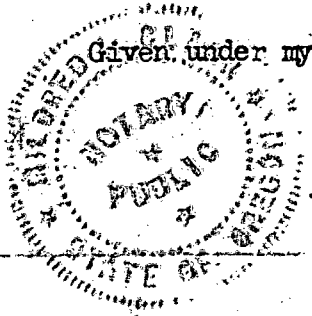
