

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF INTEREST

IN THE MATTER OF Primary State Highway No. 8, Wind River to Wind Mountain.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF The payment of costs, if any, incidental to the relocation of certain installations, the undersigned being the owner of certain easement rights for the installation of poles, guys, anchors, wires and other attachments incidental thereto, on a portion of the above subject section of highway, does hereby release and discharge the State of Washington from any and all liability, by reason of the location, construction and maintenance and operation of said highway, and herein waives and relinquishes, in favor of the State of Washington, any and all interest in and to the lands occupied by said highway and upon which the Grantor herein holds recorded or unrecorded easements, permits or rights over and across the following described lands in Skamania County, Washington, in:

The Wm. Murphy D.L.C. No. 37, the Jas. Robbins D.L.C. No. 38, Government Lots 2 and 5 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, all in Township 3 North, Range 8 East, W.M., the specific details concerning all of which are to be found within that certain map of definite location now of record and on file in the office of the Director of Highways at Olympia and bearing date of approval of June 29, 1954 and revised November 9, 1954.

This Release is made for the purpose of a limited access highway and the Grantor hereby releases and relinquishes to the Grantee any and all abutter's rights of access appurtenant to the Grantor's remaining property rights in and to said highway. RESERVING, however, unto the Grantor, its successors and assigns, access from said highway to the remaining property or property rights of the Grantor, to the extent that said access may be reasonably necessary for the operation and maintenance of its utility installations, consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires and other attachments, thereon as long as said remaining property is used in connection with such operation and maintenance and for no other purpose whatsoever.

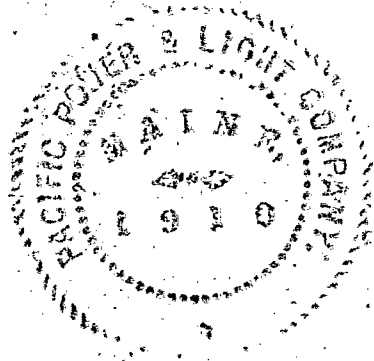

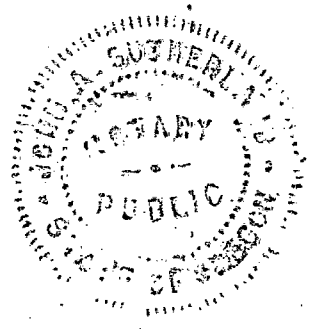
